NOTES FOR ORGANIZATION & LEADERSHIP STUDENTS:

- This emphasis is available only to students enrolled in the evening Degree Completion Program (DCP). Must have Communication Department Approval.
- The Degree Completion Program (DCP) is a cohort program & is intended that you take a substantial number of your courses with the cohort.
- Students entering the program must have an Associates Degree or at least 60 hours of college credit.
- A limited number of missing credits may be made up during the cohort, subject to the Department's Chair's discretion.
- If, when you complete the cohort, your total credits are less than 120, you will need to take additional elective courses to bring your total to 120 credits in order to graduate with a Bachelors degree. This may apply if your Associates Degree required less than 60 college credits.
- Courses are listed in numerical order, not the order in which you will take them. You are required to complete all, or CHAIR & DEAN approved course substitutions.
- Courses taken prior to entering the program do not need to be taken again if the grade achieved meets all requirements.
- Courses which are not completed or for which a student does not receive the required grade may be taken outside the cohort program to fulfill the requirement for that course.
